Dear Members of Redeemer,

I am serving you as a transition pastor. That means that my job is to provide you with pastoral care, but it also means I am to help you do the paperwork necessary for you to call a new pastor. This process of filling out paperwork can take from 6 months to a year. We formed a transition team whose job is to collect data to fill out the paperwork that is called the Ministry Site Profile. Once the Ministry Site Profile is completed, it is sent to the Central States Synod Office. It is at this point that a call committee is formed. Members of the Transition team can serve on the call committee if they wish, but usually a different group of members serve on the call committee. The only job the call committee has is to interview the pastors whose names have been given to them by the Synod Office. Pastors who are looking for a call to a congregation will be given your Ministry Site Profile and if they are interested in a call to Redeemer, the Synod Office will forward their name to the chair of the call committee. This process again can take from 6 months to a year. I really want to make all of you aware of the absolute necessity of input from every member of the congregation. The transition team will be conducting one-on-one, in-person interviews with each member of the congregation. These interviews will be conducted in the fellowship hall on two separate days. These dates will be announced in November. Before these interviews begin, you will be asked to fill out a 5-question survey that you will be asked to bring to these interviews. It is so important that we hear from each and every one of you. If you can not make the interviews, you will still be able to submit your surveys. The surveys are going to be anonymous, even for those bringing their survey to the interviews.

I wish to thank the persons who accepted the invitation to be on the transition team: Trey Potter (Chair), Charlotte Herrman, Kyle Tonniges, Wayne Keeler, Ryne Callahan, and Kris Neff. You can ask them for updates as to what is currently happening in the transition process or you can ask me.

I ask for your patience as we go through this process. Unfortunately, it is not an easy one or a quick one. Your continued prayers for me and the transition team are definitely needed. In Christ,

A gift for a prisoner is purchased by the chaplains at the prison. They ask for a donation of \$12.95 per prisoner. Deadline for returning your donations is November 23, 2025. We have to send our donation by December 1. The church council has voted to buy gifts for 20 prisoners, so anything donated from the members of Redeemer will be a bonus.
